Definitions for Public Housing Authority-funded Projects:

 \rightarrow Section 3 Worker – Any worker who currently meets, or when hired since November 30, 2020 met, one of the following criteria as documented:

- A low- or very low-income individual (the worker's income for the previous or annualized calendar year is below the income limit established by HUD); or
- Employed by a Section 3 business concern; or
- A YouthBuild participant.

 \rightarrow <u>Targeted Section 3 Worker</u> – Any worker who currently meets, or when hired since November 30, 2020 met, one of the following criteria as documented:

- Employed by a Section 3 business concern, Or
- Currently meets or when hired met a least one of the following criteria as documented since November 30, 2020:
 - A resident of public housing; or
 - A resident of other public housing projects or Section 8-assisted housing; or
 - A YouthBuild participant
